

Elm Grove Village Trustees

The proposed redevelopment of the Reinders property is one of the most important issues which Elm Grove residents and the Village Board will consider in 2016. In order to expand public involvement and participation in the planning and evaluation of this important part of our Village center I am proposing that an Advisory Committee be established to assist both the developer and the Village Board.

The Advisory Committee will serve to help define and focus public input and concerns about project plans; provide feedback to the developer; help define how a project can better reflect the public interest. This public involvement can help the land owner and developer create a better project proposal and help the Village by defining issues and concerns prior to a formal application being submitted and considered.

This ad hoc advisory body will be charged with:

- Soliciting and defining issues and concerns of site area property owners, area business owners and village residents.
- Identifying aspects of public interest in site and project design
- Assisting the project developer in understanding identified issues and concerns
- Facilitating identification of possible solutions to identified concerns

If the Board agrees that such an advisory committee can be a helpful addition to the evaluation process I recommend the appointment of the following Village residents to serve on the Village Center Advisory Committee:
