1.) Call meeting to order

Trustee & Chairperson Katy Cornell called the meeting to order at 5:35pm. There was no quorum so Village President Neil Palmer was contacted by phone.

2.) Discussion and approval of Elm Grove Zip Code Day in Elm Grove Park.

Mr. Clemins went over some of the proposed events such as a Brat Fry by the Community foundation, Third Space Brewing operating the Beer Garden and possibly securing music for the event. Trustee Cornell added that the Junior Guild would have a scavenger hunt, a possible Hashtag (TBD) on social media and promotion through Facebook, tents set up for local business to advertise but nothing to be sold and a toast by Village President and proclamation by the Governor at 5:31pm & 22 seconds.
