Item A:

As you are all aware Michelle Luedtke's last day was Tuesday January 18th. As a result the Board needs to appoint an interim village clerk to carry on the responsibilities of the office. Principal to this is the running of the upcoming elections. I am recommending the Board appoint Tom Harrigan as Interim Clerk to carry out those duties and share the remainder of the responsibilities with the rest of the general government staff. Tom has been working on learning the election process for well over a year with Michelle and prior with Mary Stredni. He is already well versed in the Wisvote.gov electronic system and has done the training for the online voter system. I am very confident he will be able to perform these duties and run a good election with the customary assistance from Village staff and citizen volunteers.

Item B:

At the last Village Board meeting the board indicated they wished to proceed with placing the proposed capital borrowing limit referendum question on the April ballot. The proposed resolution and question has been modified slightly by the Village Atty. for the purpose of clarity as allowed by state statute 9.20. The second copy of the resolution in your binder is a strike through underline version to identify the changes that have been made in language. Also included for your information is a memo from staff addressing some of the larger questions surrounding this referendum and backup materials supporting that memo.
