MINUTES

Roll Call: Robert Haugh, Allan Kasprzak and Gus Moulas and Bridget Schoenborn (via Zoom).

Also present: Police Chief Jason Kubiak

- 1. Call the Meeting to Order.** The meeting was called to order by President Robert Haugh at 7:35 A.M.

- 2. Police Chiefs update on departmental personnel.**

Chief discussed progress of School Resource Officer (SRO) position, indicating Officer Steven Weber was assigned to the position and Officer Hannah Martin was considered the SRO back up officer. Chief further described progress of supervisory and command staff and challenges with recent officer recruitment.

- 3. Interview of police officer candidates.**

A. Closed Session. President Haugh made the motion to go into closed session under Wisconsin § 19.85 (1) (c) to consider employment and compensation data over which the Police and Fire Commission exercises responsibility more specifically the identified below. The commission may reconvene in open session to take action on any item from this closed session.

- 1. Interview of police candidates.**

Mr. Moulas seconded, Roll call vote was unanimous.

President Haugh moved to go into open session, Mr. Moulas seconded. Roll call vote passed unanimously.

President Haugh made motion and Mr. Kasprzak seconded to approve Vladislav Melnikov and Raul Rivera, in that order, appointed to the position of police officer conditioned on their successful completion of a physical, fitness and psychological exam as well as execution of an employment agreement. Melnikov also had additional condition to successfully pass police academy by December of 2022. Jordan Kunya shall be approved for the same and placed on eligibility list for six months. Motion passed unanimously.

- 5. Adjournment.** President Haugh motioned and Mr. Kasprzak seconded the motion to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 9:27am.
