SUBJECT: December 2022 Summary

Village Trustees:

Attached is the monthly report for December 2022. The police department is still operating two officers below normal staffing. We recently had a voluntary resignation from the position of Sergeant in which the officer returned to his previous Patrol Officer position. This has resulted in the department having a vacant Sergeant position and a vacant Patrol Officer position. The Elm Grove Police and Fire Commission did approve the hiring of an officer candidate this week with the hope to fill the current vacant patrol officer position. The department will be starting a promotional process for the vacant Sergeant position soon.

Currently, the department is working on ten open cases. These cases involve identity theft, theft, fraud, and a burglary. These cases are being handled by the Detective Bureau. In addition, the bureau is also working on twenty additional cases involving forgery and identity theft. Although these particular cases have separate victims, they are potentially related to an investigation that is currently being coordinated with other law enforcement agencies.

No other significant incidents to report.
