Attached is the monthly report for March 2023. The police department is still operating one officer below normal staffing. The Sergeant promotional process will continue with the recent completion of the written exam and interviews scheduled this upcoming week. The department also has one potential hire for the position of Patrol Officer. The candidate's background check is currently in progress.

The Elm Grove Citizen Police Academy started this past week. This year's class currently has seventeen participants who are residents or work within the Village of Elm Grove. They will be attending class once a week, covering a variety of topics for the next nine weeks. Each attendee will also be completing a ride along with an officer for an entire shift and attend a dispatch observation. Our staff is excited for this year's class and looks forward to the opportunity in educating them in the operations of our department and law enforcement as a whole.

Currently, the department is working on seven open cases. These cases involve identity theft, theft, and fraud. These cases are being handled by the Detective Bureau. The Detective Bureau is also working on the aforementioned officer candidate background check.
