The initial goal of the show has always been to provide a fun and interesting social event for the community.

And local businesses benefitted from the publicity and goodwill generated by their participation.

Furthermore, Woller-Anger donated a good portion of its proceeds from the show to a selected charity.

And since the KIWANIS Club is a philanthropic service organization that supports programs benefiting primarily disadvantaged kids, all of the proceeds it generates go to those worthy causes.

The section of Watertown Plank Road from Juneau on the east end to Legion on the west end, will once again be the main location of the show.

Set-up work begins as early as 6am on Sunday, so the road barricades need to be available at the various drop-off points before then.

Numerous yard signs will direct show vehicles to the east end where they will line-up to enter, register and donate.

Then they will be slowly ushered westward to the sequential parking on both sides of the road.

Admission is free to the public and they are welcome to attend from 10am until 3pm.

Hot food and cold drinks are available from O'Donoghue's and the Silver Spur.

And a DJ will be spinning records and making occasional announcements.



