In response to your request for information related to safety measures I thought I would share our 2023 Training Schedule.

When we drill we work off a Drill Guide. The Guide discusses Instructor Preparation, Goals, Materials, Safety Precautions, and a Review.

Essentially every time we drill there is a measure of safety involved. Our Chief Officers as well as Company Officers are always charged with keeping training and fire ground operations as safe as possible. We work in an environment that presents numerous challenges, we do our best to train our members to recognize and avoid potential hazards. There is saying in the fire service that I believe in and always want our department to follow: "Risk a lot to save a lot, risk a little to save a little and risk nothing to save nothing."

In addition to the above we have the following safety related training:

1. Blood borne Pathogens
2. CPR/AED Recertification
3. Active Assailant Training
4. Annual Face Piece testing
5. Firefighter self-rescue
6. Elevator training
7. 4 Gas meter training
8. Monthly MPO (driver) training
9. Lock Out Tag Out training for gas meters and electrical appliances
10. Fire Ground safety
