***Resolution Approving an Intergovernmental Boundary
Agreement with Village of Elm Grove***

WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. § 66.0301 authorizes municipalities to enter into intergovernmental agreements for various purposes, including the establishment and adjustment of the boundary lines between them, and

WHEREAS, the City and Village of Elm Grove have negotiated a tentative intergovernmental boundary agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, providing for mutual agreed upon boundaries between the two municipalities, and

WHEREAS, the City Common Council held a public hearing on the terms of the proposed agreement on May 2, 2023 after due notice as required by Wisconsin State Statutes 66.0301(6)(c)1, to solicit public input on the terms of the agreement, and


WHEREAS, the City Common Council finds that the terms of the proposed agreement are reasonable and in the City's best interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Brookfield Common Council approves the intergovernmental boundary agreement attached hereto; the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the City upon approval of the same agreement by the Village of Elm Grove; and the City Clerk is directed to promptly cause the publication of the approved agreement in the manner required by Wis. Stat. § 66.0301(6)(c)2, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proper city official(s) be hereby authorized and directed to carry out the council's action, including, but not limited to signing documents, implementing technical revisions to documents to effectuate the best interest of the City, and correcting scrivener's errors.


