VILLAGE OF ELM GROVE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
RESOLUTION OF SUSPENSION OF ENFORCEMENT OF TEMPORARY SIGN ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, the Elm Grove Village Board of Trustees may temporarily suspend the enforcement of the exterior temporary sign ordinance, for a specified period of time, if such suspension would be likely to provide significant benefit to the community or if continuance of the enforcement of section 335-48D(1) of the ordinances would cause unnecessary hardship; and

WHEREAS, the Elm Grove Business Association has requested the temporary suspension of the enforcement of the exterior temporary sign ordinance during the construction and extension of water main on Watertown Plank Road in connection with the Caroline Heights Development; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that temporary suspension of the enforcement of the exterior temporary sign ordinance will likely provide significant economic benefit to the community and the continuance of the enforcement of section 335-48D(1) ordinance would likely cause unnecessary hardship to the business community;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Elm Grove Village Board does hereby resolve to temporarily suspend the enforcement of the number of permits per year, the time period, and the fee for exterior temporary signs, for the specified period of time from August 22, 2023 to November 30, 2023.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that during the specified period of time from August 22, 2023 to November 30, 2023, each business within the Village of Elm Grove located within a nonresidential district may display one temporary sign at a time, on the property where the business is located, without a permit fee being due to the Village. Provided a business proposing to place temporary signage files notification of intent to place such temporary signage before placement by e-mail, or in person on a form provided by the Zoning Administrator. Temporary signs may not be greater than 24 square feet in size. Temporary signs may not be displayed outside the specified period of time without an approved application and paid permit fee. Temporary signs not adhering to the requirements of this Resolution may be removed by the Village without prior notification.
