

Item 3: Review and possible action on construction bid for Highland Drive North Pedestrian Pathway Project.

Construction bids for the Highland Drive North Pedestrian Pathway were opened on March 14, 2024, with C.W. Purpero, Inc. being the lowest qualified bidder at \$495,920. Peter Gesch, of Ruekert & Mielke, has provided the enclosed bid tabulation memo for your review. Mr. Gesch has included an updated total project cost estimate which identifies several unanticipated expenses related to the CPKC railroad crossing. As noted, Mr. Gesch has been diligently working to coordinate approval for the new pedestrian crossing with CP Rail and the Office of the Commissioner of the Railroad (OCR). Please review the memo for a comprehensive detail of these challenges to date, potential project cost impacts related to timing of approvals, and possible additional improvement requirements from CP Rail or the OCR.

The total estimated project cost, inclusive of engineering and an 18% contingency is \$784,270.

If the Committee desires to move forward with the recommendation by R&M to award the construction contract, a motion should be made to the Board of Trustees for approval of the construction bid submitted by C.W. Purpero in the amount of \$495,920.
