Dear David,

Thank you for reaching out regarding the possible cul de sac at Underwood PKWY. I am in favor this.

Here are a few points of feedback I'd like to address:

Safety & Noise ó as the road is set to be widened, this will increase the amount of vehicular noise and amount of traffic. New landscaping between the cul de sac and North Ave. should help absorb some of the noise. Safety also is at a risk with the widened road. Since this street only has houses on one side, we're more vulnerable to criminals ducking down our street and having a look around. We have no one across the street helping keep watch as others do.

Hazardous Intersection ó speeding is a major issue on North Avenue and will only get worse with more traffic. Visibility is usually obstructed during heavy traffic times in the morning and evening commutes. Making a left turn onto Underwood PKWY from North Ave. during the evening commute is a stressful experience. I always wonder when I'd be rear-ended as I see cars merge over to pass at the last second when my car is stopped for the left turn at Underwood PKWY. I now use either Lilly Rd. or Mt. Kisco as it is a visibly safer route.

There are no negative impacts for myself or family if Underwood PKWY were to be transformed into a cul de sac. I feel it would help keep our street safe and our kids safe.
