I'm writing with my support for the Mandel project on Watertown Plank Rd. Can you please share with the plan commission?

I am supportive of this project in Elm Grove for several reasons. I've been a resident here since 2005, and have owned three homes in the Village. I enjoy many of the services of the Village, and patronize the businesses that are here, but like many of my neighbors, I'd love to see more. My kids go to Tonawanda, and it is a great school. I know that schools and services are paid by taxes, and that businesses prefer to locate in communities with a vibrant and active population. Replacing an under-utilized convent that isn't on the tax rolls with a well-designed apartment and single-family-home project that brings residents (and additional spending in the village) and tax base is a great gain for Elm Grove. As many of our long-time residents age out of their homes, this will offer an option to stay in their community in a more appropriate living space. It will also make way for other families to move into those homes. Transactions of home sales will benefit all other residents by creating options for others to grow into bigger homes, increase their property values, and provide more options for housing stock in the Village.
