We love birds and we bet that you do too. But did you know that we have lost nearly 3 billion birds in North America since 1970? Birds need our help, and so our team is participating in the Great Wisconsin Birdathon to help #BringBirdsBack!

How does the Birdathon work? Well, our team is setting a goal to find as many birds as possible within a single day, all while raising funds to support bird conservation in Wisconsin. Our team is hoping to raise \$3000! We'll be participating on June 6th at Elm Grove Village Park and we would be grateful for any donation you can make to support us. To participate in the walk and/or donate funds, go to www.wisconservation.org/Birdathon and click "Get Involved". Registration is free, and after you register you can choose to participate on our team at the June 6 bird count walk from 1-3 pm (meet outside the library doors by the bird feeders). Our team name is Elm Grove High Flyers. If you cannot be there in person that day, you can find birds on your own within that 24 hour period and report back your findings to the team leaders. There is an "ebird" app sponsored by the Cornell Lab of Ornithology that you can download and report your bird sightings as well. If you would like to donate to the Birdathon, you can click "donate" on the wisconservation.org/Birdathon site; you may donate by check or credit card, whichever you prefer. Funds raised through the Birdathon directly support the Natural Resources Foundation's Bird Protection Fund. Half of all money raised by our team will be returned to our Elm Grove community to support our Bird City WI mission and projects.
