

RESOLUTION 082922

**A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT A QUESTION TO A REFERENDUM
REGARDING THE RECONSTRUCTION OF GEBHARDT ROAD AND PATHWAY
CONSTRUCTION**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is important to maintain Village of Elm Grove streets and develop an interconnected pathway system; and

WHEREAS, a spending limit referendum was approved at the general election in April 2022 requiring all public works projects that exceed \$1,000,000 in expenditure to be approved by referendum vote; and

WHEREAS, the Village has applied for an STP grant for the reconstruction and pathway from the State of Wisconsin for a total of \$1,700,000, exclusive of engineering, which is an 80% federal and a 20% local funding split with \$1,360,000 being federally funded and \$340,000 being the Village's portion and;

WHEREAS, in the alternative to receiving the STP grant funds the Village would proceed with the reconstruction and pathway fully funding the construction of project at \$1,300,000, exclusive of engineering, with Village funds.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Elm Grove Board of Trustees have determined this project to be in the best interest of the Village of Elm Grove and therefore shall be put forward to the electorate at the November 8th, 2022 election: and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to WI Stats §66.0803 (1) (b) and (c) the Village of Elm Grove Board of Trustees hereby submit the following question to a referendum to be on the November 8th, 2022 ballot:

“Shall the Village of Elm Grove expend \$1,700,000 on the reconstruction of Gebhardt Road including the construction of an off road pathway with the Village's expected contribution to be \$340,000 after federal grant monies?

Second question:

“Shall the Village of Elm Grove expend \$1,300,000 for the reconstruction of Gebhardt Road including the construction of an off road pathway exclusively with Village funds in the event that federal grant monies are not awarded?
