Summer is a great time to volunteer at the library! Here are your options this year:

1. **Set-up/Take-down for weekly programs.** Volunteers should be available 10:00-11:30 am so they can help with both set-up and take-down. Only a few volunteers are needed for each date so applications for program volunteers will be accepted until June 30<sup>th</sup> or until all positions are filled, whichever comes first. Please fill out the application below and **include the specific dates you are available to help**. We may not need your help on every date you are available, so you will be notified of the dates you are assigned by email.
  - Thursday, June 12 – Science Heroes (includes hands-on experiments)
  - Thursday, June 19 – Little Miss Ann (music)
  - Thursday, June 26 – Zack Percell (magician)
  - Thursday, July 17 – J&R Aquatic Animal Rescue (includes live animals)
  - Thursday, July 24 – The Pocket Lady™ (storytelling)
  - Thursday, July 31 – Wehr Nature Center (interactive program about snakes)
2. **Summer Build-It Club and The Recycled Art Challenge** – Build It Club activities include building with Legos™ and Keva Planks and coding with Ozobots. The Recycled Art Challenge is an opportunity for kids to create original art using found objects. Volunteers will set up the room, help participants, and clean up.
